### Steps to Share Your SSD Photos on Flickr

#### Upload your photos

1. Go to [www.flickr.com/](http://www.flickr.com/) and sign in to an existing Yahoo account (or click Create your Account if you don't already have one.)
2. Use the **Upload Photos and Video** function to upload your photographs to your account.

Under **Set Privacy**, please leave the default setting of *Public*.

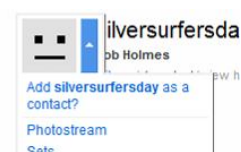
Please tag your photos SSD09.

Use the **Description** box to say where your Event was held.

#### Share your photos with us

3. Use the **Contacts** menu to do a *People Search* for silversurfersday.
4. In the results, hold your mouse pointer over the icon and choose *Add silversurfersday as a contact?* from the drop-down menu.

That will tell us that you have set up your account and let us see your photos – and more important – invite you to join the Silver Surfers' Day group.



5. When we reply, you'll see you have a message at the top right of your Flickr Home page
6. Click on the envelope icon to see your messages.
7. Open your invitation, and click Yes to accept.
